The August regular board meeting was called to order by Bob Zach at 6 pm,

The Rec Center will have designated "Eclipse Parking" available for \$5.00 a day, showers available for \$3.00 and water sales. Sharon also stated she would like to partner with the Birch Glenn Motel with the Rec Center.

**Proposed Budget:** The Proposed Budget, see attached, was published in the Star News and posted on the Rec Center Board. Troy Huckaby opened a discussion on the assessment made prior to the building of the Center and the current assessment and how it was determined. The board and Tom Greco discussed the loss of 175 household lots due to new regulations and how that determined the assessment for the next year.

Judy Nissula, City Councilwoman, opened a discussion on the MOU for the Sports Complex and how the City of Cascade and the Cascade Aquatic and Recreation Center could benefit each other with a partnership there. Tom Greco discussed, the hope of becoming a "hub" for recreation.

Bob Zach motioned to approve the proposed budget with the caveat that if another meeting was warranted another meeting would be held, Denise Snyder seconded.
